Certificate 'Medical Education' (Yr 1)

Study units: Personal/Professional Development; Teaching Methods; Assessment; Communication & Educational Media. The units are linked to assessed written assignments and two observations of your teaching.



Diploma 'Medical Education' (Yr 2)

Study units: Research Methods Curriculum Development; Assessment; Organisation, Leadership and Management of Teaching. The units are linked to assessed pieces of work.



MSc 'Medical Education' (Yr 3)

Year three comprises the writing and submission of a dissertation on a medical education topic.
